Since 1870 there is The Polish Museum on the Castle Hill in Rapperswil. The Poles had the partial destroyed Castle again rebuilt. Rapperswil became the stronghold of Polish hopes, meetings and ideas. Also Swiss poet Gottfried Keller supported the liberty efforts that Poland. Until today it is an institution without firm employee and without subsidies of the public hand. The Polish Museum pays annually a rent of 20'000.- CHF to the local municipality Rapperswil Jona. The exhibition offers a view also into the history of the versatile Swiss-Polish relations. The Polish Museum counts annually against 10'000 visitors - from all the World. From it profits the tourism, the hotel trade, the catering trade and the image of the city.
